The *M/V Columbia Point* is an all-weather 110-passenger, 64ft U.S. Coast Guard-certified vessel used for academic research, educational programs and charters. The ADA-accessible vessel is eco-friendly: low wake wash, EPA Tier II green engines burning ultra-low sulfur fuel, biocide free anti-fouling paint, and zero discharge sanitary systems.
